Arriving in Freiburg

\rightarrow By train

You can find cabs outside the main hall of the train station to your right or the trams leaving from the platform on the bridge just above the railroad tracks. For information on getting around Freiburg, please see section "Getting around in Freiburg" of this guide!

\rightarrow By bus:

Should you choose to take a bus to get to Freiburg, you will probably arrive at the ZOB next to the main station. To get to the trams, walk towards the station building and take the escalator, lift, or stairs to get to the bridge and the tram stops. Cabs are outside the main entrance hall to your right.

→ By plane (Basel or Frankfurt Airport)

If you are at the airport in Basel (Euroairport), you can either purchase your ticket in advance (https://www.freiburger-reisedienst.de/index.php or through Flixbus) or buy it on the day of your trip from the bus driver directly. Either way, the price for the 55-minute one-way trip is 23€. The timetable can be found on the website above. The bus will take you directly to the ZOB (arrival for buses at the central train station in Freiburg). Once there, please follow the instructions given above.

If you arrive at **Frankfurt Airport (FRA Airport)**, follow the signs to Frankfurt Flughafen FERNBAHNHOF (tief), the train station is directly at the airport. There is a regular fast train service (some trains direct) to Freiburg within 2-3 hours.

\rightarrow By car:

You will probably take the A5 (Karlsruhe-Freiburg) or arrive via the B31 in the East. Please check with your hotel if they offer parking for their guests. If not, or if you have chosen not to stay at a hotel, you have several options:

- Park your car for free on a P+R (Park + Ride)
 parking area and navigate the city using

 I Do pay attention to the different parking zones, the prices for parking vary (1.30€-3.20€/h)
- Find an available parking spot and pay the fee at a parking metre (this is not really advisable as parking spots are hard to find in Freiburg).



Event locations










IMBIT/Technical Faculty, Georges-Köhler-Allee 201 (Location Day 1: Wednesday, September 14)



To get to the IMBIT building take tram 4 from "Stadttheater" to "Technische Fakultät" (direction "Messe"). From there it is only a five minutes' walk to the IMBIT building. Parking available on the premises.





KG I, Platz der Universität 3, 79098 (Location Day 2: Thursday, September 15)







The KG I is a quick 3minute walk away from the Tram station theatre ("Stadttheater") – be sure to visit the southern entrance of the building with the two philosophers. Do not try

to engage in discussions, as we are afraid their opinions are set in stone. Parking possible in a parkade or underground parking lot close by.

Botanical Garden/Faculty of Biology, Schänzlestraße 1 (Location Day 3: Friday, September 16)






Simply take the tram number 4 from the city center to "Hauptstraße" (direction "Zähringen") and walk for 3 minutes to the Botanical Garden. Use the entry on the other side of the road for the AB guided tour. Meeting point: LivMatS Pavillon. No parking on premises, 3 parking lots close by (see map).








Historisches Kaufhaus (Dinner location for Advisory Board, Steering Committee members and invited guests only on Thursday, September 15):





In a little under 10 minutes, you can get from the event location KG I to the dinner location of the night. The walk through the city centre is short and easy. Walk towards the Freiburg Münster (the big cathedral), which can easily be seen on your way through town. The Historische Kaufhaus is at the right side of the cathedral square (colourful roof!) when you stand in front of the cathedral entrance.

Peterhofkeller (Dinner location for all other guests on Thursday, September 15):






Just about the briefest walk ever – get from one location to the other in just 2 minutes.

To get to Peterhofkeller, simply exit KG I and walk across a courtyard.





Meeting Point for the Historic guided city Tour: Am Predigertor (Thursday, September 15, 9:30pm):





Depending on your dinner location, the two maps below show you the way. In either case, your walk will be quite short (Left: Historisches Kaufhaus, Right: Peterhofkeller).

Meeting Point for the Pub Crawl: Platz der alten Synagoge (Thursday, September 15, 9:30pm)



Depending on your dinner location, the maps below show where you will meet the rest of the group for fun night out! The way is basically the same as from the KG I to your respective dinner location (Top: Historisches Kaufhaus, Bottom: Peterhofkeller).








Getting around in Freiburg

→ Public transport:

Freiburg's public transportation network consists of two main modes of transportation: Buses and trams.

As the network is quite extensive and there are several construction sites at the moment, we recommend using the VAG App "VAG mobil" or "RVF-FahrPlan+" (apps for public transportation in Freiburg).



It can be found in the app store and is available for iPhone and Android. You will be asked to register as a new user – exceptions can be made if you would like to pay with PayPal.

You can also use the ticket machines in the trams/at some tram stops, or from the bus driver, but the mobile ticket is often the more convenient choice. Single-ride tickets and 24h-tickets are 10% cheaper if purchased online.





Recommendation: For your stay, consider purchasing the **WelcomeTicket** (valid for 3 days, **27**€). It is a personalized ticket that you can use for all means of regional transport and additionally for the Schauinslandbahn (a cable car up to the Schauinsland mountain, which normally costs 13.50€). You can also visit **5 museums** (indicated in section "Museums and Cultural Offerings") **for free**!

Alternatively, you can purchase a **24h-ticket** (valid from the time of purchase for 24h), which is **6** \in . The 24h-ticket is also available for purchase for 2 people (9 \in total, 3 \in saved) or for 5 people (12 \in total, 18 \in saved). So, if you're attending the forum with friends or colleagues, this is a smart option as well.





→ Rental bikes:

Freiburg has a fantastic rental bike system called FRELO. With bike stations all over the city (and the surrounding villages), the accessibility is incredible. As a standard customer, the rate is 1€/30 min. How to use of the Frelo System:





- Get the "VAG mobil" or "Nextbike" app for your phone and verify your account (you will need to add a starting balance of 1€ to your account – this can be done with Paypal, your credit card or in form of a direct debit)
- 3. Use the app to find a Frelo station with free bikes and scan the QR code on the bike to rent it. Should the QR code not work, you can also enter the number manually.
- 4. You're good to go! Happy pedalling!
- 5. A word of caution: Don't forget to lock your bike at your destination Frelo station as leaving it unlocked is a rather expensive mistake.

Freiburg and its surroundings

Schauinsland (Cable Car Trip)




Take a scenic cable car ride up the Schauinsland mountainside! For just 13.50€ or for free with the VAG WelcomeTicket, you can get to (nearly) the very top of this fantastic mountain and back down again. You may also want to climb the last bit to the summit and enjoy the panoramic view. The popular viewing tower is currently under construction. The Schauinsland

restaurant is perfectly located right next to the cable car stop at the top, where you can take a break for refreshments and a hearty snack.

You can also hike up the Schauinsland but this will take several hours.

How to get there:





From the tram stop "Stadttheater", take tram line 2 going to "Günterstal". Get off at "Dorfstraße" and get on the bus (line 21 to Horben) and finally get off at "Schauinslandbahn Tal".

There, you can purchase your tickets and take the cable car up to the top.





Titisee



The Titisee is the biggest natural lake in the Black Forest and a lovely place to spend the afternoon. For 7-12€ you can rent a row or pedal boat. There is a multitude of cafés, restaurants and souvenir shops around the lake.

You can also walk around the lake (~6km), which should not take much longer than 90 minutes and is an easy route with few to no steep bits.

How to get there:

From Freiburg central train station, take either the S1 (regional train) going to Neustadt or the S10 going to Villingen and get off at "Titisee". The train ride takes between 30-40 minutes depending on the train line. Your WelcomeTicket covers the train ride. If you are using a 24h-ticket or a single ticket, make sure you get one for fare zone 3 (because Titisee and Freiburg are in different fare zones).

Schlossberg

Located close to the city centre, the Schlossberg is a fantastic way of experiencing nature without a lengthy hike. In just 10-15 minutes (at a comfortable pace), you can get to the Kanonenplatz (see picture) and enjoy the view. After another 15-20 minutes walk you get to the viewing tower. You can also visit the beer garden ("Kastaniengarten") for beer and small dishes.










How to get there:

From the city centre, you can get to the Kanonenplatz in just under 20 minutes. When you get to the Schwabentorsteg (picture below), head up the stairs and across the bridge. From there, begin the brief climb to the Kanonenplatz.





Münstermarkt (Mon-Sat 8am-2pm)

If you are looking for fresh products, cute souvenirs, or some Bratwurst, this is the place for you! You can also buy plants, meat and wooden cooking utensils here. Stop for a quick bite at one of the many Bratwurst food trucks and try Freiburg's "Lange Rote" (a very popular sausage in a bun) or the vegan Tofu version.



How to get there:

The market square is right by the Münster (cathedral) in the city centre and just a 3-minute walk from the city centre (Bertoldsbrunnen tram stop).
